- 13: Purple points, located in the area around the Aare river, near the Gryphenhübeli.
- 14: Orange points, located in the area around the Aare river, near the Gryphenhübeli.
- 15: Green points, located in the area around the Aare river, near the Gryphenhübeli.
- 16: Blue points, located in the area around the Aare river, near the Gryphenhübeli.

The map also shows various streets and landmarks, including the Aare river, the Gryphenhübeli, and the Rotes Quartier.
